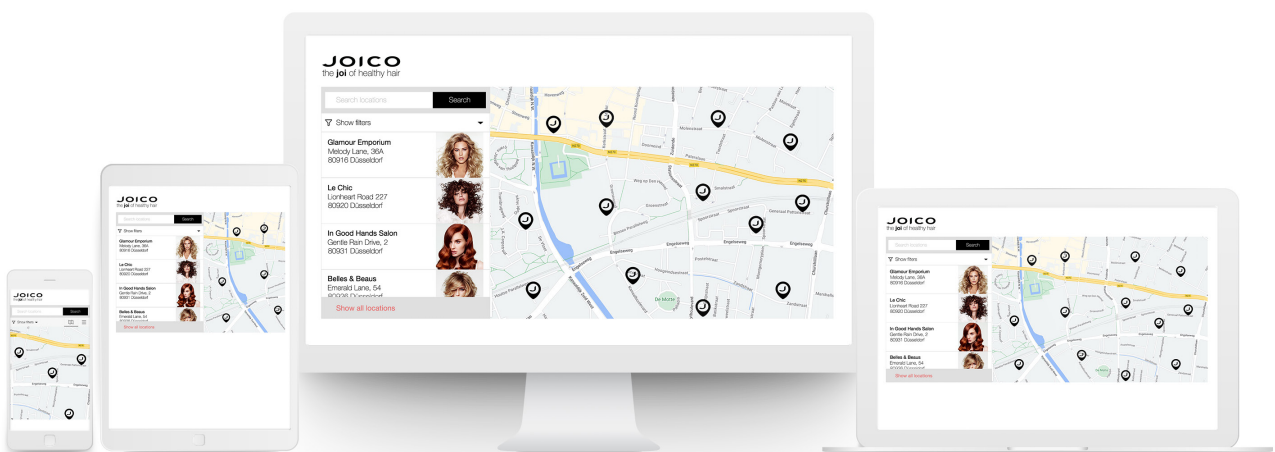

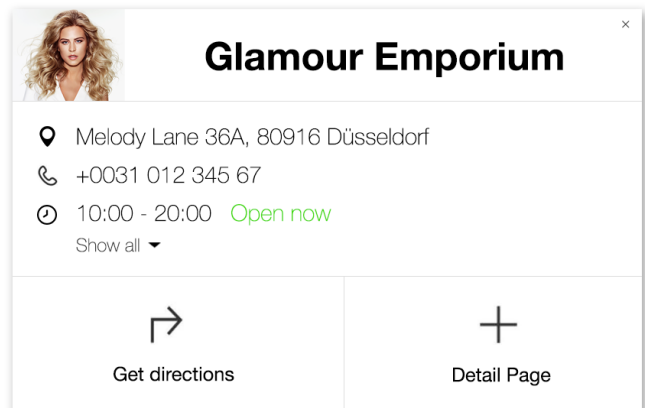
HOW TO BE PART OF THE JOICO SALON FINDER?

- Address
- Phone number
- Opening hours
- E-mail address (for JOICO to contact the salon regarding this Salon Finder)

- Services you offer – tell your clients, what your real power is about
